LOCAL AUTHORITY PREVENTION DEMONSTRATION PROGRAMME

Nine companies have agreed to work with Monaghan Co Co in this initiative in the hope of doing their bit for the environment and achieving savings in waste, water, and energy costs. Initial audits have yielded action plans that will result in cost savings on implementation. A barrier that the initiative has come across is that it takes a long time to develop prevention programmes with the private sector. Distrust in the private sector of Local Authorities needs to be broken down and overcome.



One of the successes of the programme has been the work undertaken within the hospitality sector. The Glencarn Hotel, Castleblaney is one of the business that has engaged with the LAPD team and has implemented the agreed action plan and noticed savings in its energy and waste costs.

Cleaner production audits have been undertaken a range of businesses and action plans have been prepared and are in various stages of production in Feldhues, Clones; Rangeland Meats, Castleblaney; Coyle's Commercial Sprayers, Carrickroe; BOSE Ireland; Aidan McKenna, Sprayer, Ballybay; Westenra Hotel, Monaghan; Glencarn Hotel, Castleblaney; Squealing Pig, Monaghan; Essexford Joinery.

Monaghan Co Co's initiative focusing on "Manufacturing and Business Sector" is one of a programme entitled "Working Together to Prevent Waste in Co Monaghan". The programme has received €421,127 under phase 1 of the Local Authority Prevention Demonstration Programme.
